In December 2010 he joined Ballet Philippines as an Apprentice. A year after he was promoted as a Company Member. In January 2022 he joined Sacramento Ballet under the direction of Anthony Krutzkamp as a Company Member and retired in May 2024. His notable repertoire includes, Val Caniparoli's Tutto Eccetto iL Lavandino and Ibsen's House, Jennifer Archibald's Soar, George Balanchine's Allegro Brillante, Nicole Haskin's Groundless Shift, Julia Feldman's Hearts and Appassionata, Jermaine Spivey's Course of Action, Alejandro Cerrudo's Extremely Close, Marika Brussel's New Piece, Cavalier and Snow King in The Nutcracker, Von Rothbart in Anthony Krutzkamp's Swan Lake, and Stepsister in Paul Vasterling's Cinderella. As of May 2024 he officially retired from dancing and is pursuing his new career as an educator in ballet at Westlake School of the Performing Arts, Daly City.
